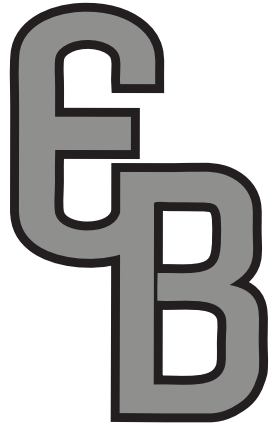

It is our pleasure to invite you to our 24th Annual Genetic Seed Saver Sale on November 16, 2019 at Em Brook Farms, Schellsburg, PA 15559. The sale will start at 12:30 PM. Cows can be viewed on sale day prior to lunch or before sale day by just giving one of us a call. We are very excited about this year's offerings. As usual, we will sell the entire 2016 three-year-old class as our main group. After a number of requests, we will also be selling 2 of our “Elite Wye Donor Cows”. Both of these Donor cows are straight Wye Angus breeding and are Lots # 3 and # 8 for more information, please check their descriptions.

Our “PICK OF THE FLUSH” was a big success in last year's sale and is back again this year as Lot # 1. The 2018 “PICK OF THE FLUSH” produced 18 embryos for the buyer in 2019 and we look for more success in 2020 from the Qualton Pair. This year's “PICK” will be one of three outstanding “Prince of Malpas” (2776941) heifers. We find Prince of Malpas to not only be rare but our way back to yesteryear in the cattle industry thru our IVF program. Our IVF program is designed to develop a maternal standard in our genetics. This standard is the “Pursuit of Excellence” thru “Old Reliable Genetics” in developing cows for low input, grass based and maternal efficiency. The three Prince daughters in this year's “PICK” are right on in this pursuit. (See more details under Lot # 1)

Along with the “PICK OF THE FLUSH” we are very excited about our embryo and ET programs as we continue to expand both entities. We are always looking for feedback on our programs. The report back from Ben Loyning in Montana was 7 out of 8 conceptions for 87.5% on his 2 lots of embryos and Matt Morgan in Kentucky used 2 embryos of his 3 Prince of Malpas and had both conceive. Using Trans Ova in Boonesboro, MD give us a seamless approach to embryo and ET success and we want to acknowledge them for this. On the ET side we added 3 heifers by Vindicator of Milford (2864524) out of our 109 Donor, O Miss Father L 28-109 (16346978), she is for sale as Lot # 3 and is out of our Forceful of Wye (8792721) daughter the # 12 cow Queen Mother of Wye 10409 (17606176). We also added a Qualton of Wye (8180039) out of our Babine 90 Donor. The # 12 cow (10409) continues to impress us with her Donor performance, we now have 2 ET bulls from her to Prince of Malpas and Fabron of Wye (2467117). On the embryo side, we have 14 lots of straight Wye embryos offered in Lot # 2, as well as 4 lots of our old favorites. We think there is something for everyone looking for Wye Angus genetics. Please check Lot # 2.

And so, our cattlemen's journey continues with you our friends and customers. We have Swope Auctioneers and Marketing Group again taking care of our videos, catalog prep and sale day bidding in the sale barn or by phone/conference call for those who cannot be with us. We will be using a phone conference line this year. Please check with one of us for the sale day number and to get registered. From all of us at Octoraro, Em Brook and Octoraro Epiphany, thank-you for your continued interest and support of our Angus cattle programs. We look forward to seeing you on November 16th. Our special 50 % partnership offering features a series of flushes from our 3 ET Prince of Malpas (2776941) daughters. The 3 were born in 2018, one out of our #10 cow Copeland of Wye UMF 10087 (17051360) a Lonestar of Wye (7478224) daughter and two out of our #12 cow Queen Mother of Wye UMF 10409 (17606176) a Forceful of Wye (8792721) daughter. The 1st of 3 is OEB Miss Prince 803 (19242001) she is a double granddaughter of Prince and the other 2 are OEB Miss Prince 804 and OEB Miss Prince 808 go back to Forceful (DOB 01/31/1976), a son of Valour of Ardrass (2632813) and grandson of Prince Paul of Barnoldby (AACAS 142220B). These heifers are line bred for maternal efficiency at its best In our quest to preserve the old reliable, trouble free Angus females, we chose these matings to produce linebred, purebred, and trouble free genetics that we feel are needed to restore our breed. Maternal Angus qualities have been diminished through selection for terminal growth and dollar beef value. The future of our Angus breed starts with females bred like these with a specific selection toward "MATERNAL PARENT STOCK".

"PICK OF THE FLUSH"

Guidelines for the sale of a 50% partnership with Octoraro/Em Brook Angus for future IVF flushes for the successful buyer's pick of the three (3) Prince of Malpas daughters: OEB Miss Prince 803, OEB Miss Prince 804 or OEB Miss Prince 808.

- Partner will share in the decision of what semen (from our inventory) to be used in the flushes.
- Donor cow will stay at Em Brook board free.
- All prep labor, transportation to collection facility and administration of partnership records all covered by Octoraro/Em Brook.
- Production costs for collection will be shared equally.
- Embryos will be split 50-50. Partner will take possession of their 50%.
- Natural born calves of donor are not part of this partnership.
- Octoraro/Em Brook will insure the value of the successful bid for 3 years for an untimely death of the donor.

Embryo Lots

We have always focused on maternal efficiency. We demand a moderate framed, 1200 pound, easy keeping, long lived and trouble free type of female. Years ago, we noticed that our breed had been downgraded to nothing more than registered black composites. At that time we started a program to stockpile semen on some of the old pillar bulls of the breed that had the ability to transmit the maternal goodness that we focus on. Today, we are using those bulls in our embryo program. In recent years the commercial breeder has begun to notice that the females of today are not as long lived, trouble free and productive with as good of udder quality, feet and leg structure as what the old Angus cows previously had. To accomplish our goal, to preserve the maternal goodness of the Angus breed, we feel that we have to return to the linebred, purebred type females of the past. They were easy keeping, long lived and trouble free. They worked well in the past and they will work in the future to correct some of the fallacies that have resulted from single trait selection for terminal traits that is being used today.

2A embryos are out of the Queen Mother #12 cow. She is a Forceful daughter. Forceful was a son of the imported bull, Valour. There is a lot of goodness in this female, excellent in her kind, fancy uddered and the bonus is that she excels at producing embryos. We chose to breed her to Bonanza of Wye. We recently acquired the Bonanza semen. Bonanza's dam is the cow that we are trying to replicate. She was the Blythe cow. She weaned over five and ½ tons of calves in her lifetime. She is a Geordus daughter, out of a Mulben Envoist daughter. All these bulls were imported and had the ability to transmit the traits that we are looking for. We are selling four IVF non-sexed embryos by old Bonanza. They are worthy of your consideration.

2B These embryos are out of a Father of Wye daughter, 109. She is absolutely a beautiful cow and one of the best cows that we have ever been affiliated with. She is deep bodied, with a strong maternal wedge, beautiful udder and a fancy front end. She is just the ideal cow to help preserve the maternal function in the Angus breed. We are offering three IVF sexed female embryos sired by Federal. Federal was a Career son of Prince of Malpus and out of Fabron's dam, the Matilda cow. Federal was a tremendous bull. I remember his daughters, as they were real deal brood cows.

2C These embryos are out of the same cow as lot 2B, 109 is a good Father of Wye daughter. The three IVF non-sexed embryos were sired by Banjo of Wye. Banjo is a Lonestar son. Lonestar's dam was the famous Luria cow and she produced over five tons of calves and was the oldest living Pathfinder cow. Banjo did a remarkable job in the Deboo Diamond D program in Valier, MT., breeding fertility, longevity and maternal function into their females. These embryos are tightly linebred to Prince of Malpus.

2D is another offering from the Father of Wye 109 cow. There are four IVF non-sexed embryos sired by Churchill of Wye being offered. Churchill was a son of Lodge of Wye, who had genetic defect free status. His dam was the famous Colleen cow, a daughter of the imported Gaird of Dalmeny bull. Colleen was noted by Jim Lingle, "As the greatest matron to ever walk the Wye Plantation pastures". Colleen was also the dam of Columbus and Corbin. An excellent mating in this offering.

2E These embryos are out of Miss Prince 808, a young cow that we love. She is a daughter of Prince of Malpas, out of the Forceful sired #12 cow. She has tremendous capacity, fleshing ease and is very correct and pleasing in her kind. We have high hopes for this cow. She is a good embryo producer and we are selling three IVF sexed female embryos sired by Favour of Wye. Favour was sired by Lodge of Wye who was an excellent stock bull. Favour was a real udder improver and female maker.

2F These embryos are out of the same cow as lot 2E, Miss Prince 808. The four IVF non-sexed embryos are sired by Fabron or Wye. When you have an outstanding Prince daughter, it is hard to determine what bull will provide the most complimentary service. When uncertain, we fall back to old Fabron of Wye. Fabron was a Foremost son out of Matilda G. out of the imported Gaird bull. Fabron has a proven track record at Wye for producing females. He was Jim Lingle's masterpiece bull.

2G and 2H Embryo lots are out of Queen Mother of Wye 10409, the #12 cow, sired by Forceful of Wye. These embryos were sired by Churchill. As noted previously, Churchill was a son of the Colleen cow. 5 IVF non-sexed embryos sired by Churchill are being offered in each of these lots.

2I This lot of embryos is out of Miss Qualton 809, a young female that we like and was sired by Qualton of Wye. Qualton is a Lonestar son that goes back to Luria to Prince of Malpus. 809's dam was our good Alap female, Babs 90, that we had great success with in our embryo program. We are offering two IVF non-sexed females sired by Churchill out of the young 809.

2J These embryos are out of Queen Mother of Wye 10409 who is the #12 cow, sired by Forceful of Wye. Three IVF non-sexed embryos, sired by Qualton of Wye will be selling. Qualton was a Lonestar son that was used successfully in the Shoshone herd in Wyoming. Qualton was a real female maker transmitting quality udders and excellent maternal function.

2K and 2L are embryos from Queen Mother of Wye 10409 and she goes back goes back to the #12 cow. These two lots of four IVF sexed embryos are sired by Fargo of Wye. Fargo was a Landrover son out of the fine Farrah cow, a daughter of Father of Wye. Farrah was a daughter of the Flarabell cow that went back to Fabeola. Fabeola was a daughter of the imported Geordus bull. Fargo did an outstanding job at the Irvington Farm in Georgia and was used back into the Wye program. He can definitely transmit the traits that we are looking for.

2M This lot of embryos is out of the Copeland of Wye cow, the #10 cow. She is a daughter of Lonestar with a fancy pedigree. This is an excellent young cow that does a fine job, with a good udder, good structure and feet. We love this cow and her pedigree. We are offering three of her IVF non-sexed embryos sired by Boyd of Wye. Boyd was a son of Vindicator of Milford, a very good imported bull that was used successfully in the Wye program. Boyd did things so well and did nothing wrong that years later Wye brought him back into their program and they now have eight bred yearling daughters. We purchased Boyd semen and are very enthused about using this Vindicator son in our flush program. We have three weanling Vindicator daughters in the herd that will be in the "Pick of the Flush" in our 25th sale in 2020.

2N These embryos are out of Em Brook Miss Wix 203 who is one of Sam's favorite cows. She is an Octoraro Emulation 310 daughter out of our 801 cow. There is a lot of power bred into this cow family. Five IVF sexed female embryos, sired by N Bar Emulation 5522 will be offered. 5522's claim to fame was that he was EXT's sire. EXT was the most heavily used bull in the beef industry. 5522 can do things that we like better than EXT did. He transmits excellent udders and maternal function. They are strictly low input cattle, easy keeping, good momma cows. He has worked extremely well on our cow base at Octoraro Angus. He never misses and does an excellent job every time.

2O These embryos are out of Octoraro Delia 227, an old cow that we lost last year in her late teens. She was a direct daughter of our foundation 503 E31, Viking cow. Ron Bolze, formerly with CAB and now teaching at Chadron State College in Nebraska and working with the Nebraska Grazing Collation stated that 503 was the greatest cow that ever walked. Four IVF sexed female embryos out of 227 and sired by 5522 are being offered. That cross has always worked well for us.

2P This lot of embryos is from Octoraro Gammer 203 that lived to a ripe old age, as did her dam, a Viking cow. 203 was sired by Rito O54. She did a fine job for us and was a fancy uddered cow even in her later years. These four traditional non-sexed embryos were sired by 5522 and are sure to please.

2Q The Em Brook Miss Wix 801 embryos are from another of Sam's all-time favorite cows and she was sired by the Pinebank Wai Group 41/97 bull. She has tremendous volume and capacity, an excellent maternal wedge, and is fancy fronted. We are selling four IVF sexed heifer embryos sired by our good, old female maker Octoraro Emulation 310 bull. This fall we brought home an embryo heifer from the recip herd in W. Va. that was from this flush. Do not miss the opportunity to purchase embryos identical to what we use ourselves.

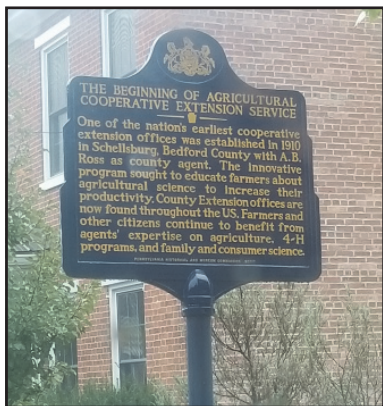
2R These embryos are out of Octoraro Gammer 305 who was a beautiful, young Emblazon sired female. OCC Emblazon was double bred to FO203. 305's dam was the Gammer 203 cow, a Rito O54, Viking cow. Three non-sexed traditional embryos out of Gammer 305 and sired by Octoraro Emulation 310 are being offered.

O Miss Father L 28-109 is a donor cow that Sam and Rick purchased in partnership from Oliver Angus in Georgia, last fall. She is an aged cow, a direct daughter of Father of Wye. Remember Father's dam was a good Prince of Malpas daughter. This cow's bottom side reads a double shot of Fargo of Wye, and linebreeds back into the great old brood cow, 935 Fabiola of Wye, a Geordus daughter. We used reverse sorted Federal semen on 109 and three of her IVF sexed heifer embryos are being offered. Banjo was also used IVF on this cow and has three non-sexed embryos offered this year. 109 is deep and spacious, beautifully structured with a fancy udder. This is a fine old brood cow with an outstanding pedigree. We are very pleased with her, so do not overlook these embryos.

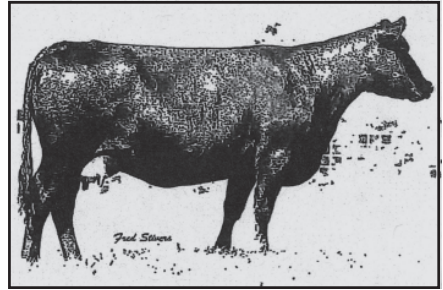

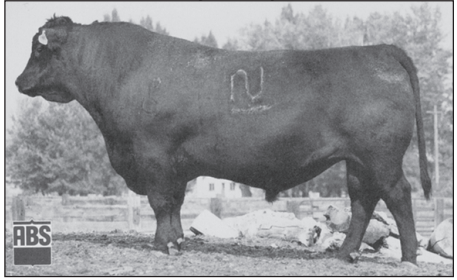

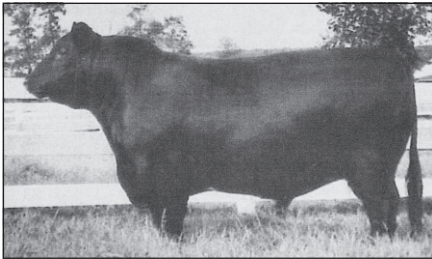

triple bred Emulation 31 that carried 13% IBC. 5154 was developed on a total forage program - never had a mouthful of grain, and is probably suffering from a little inbred depression. However, we think he is a true seed stock bull that can breed with consistency and prepotency due to his IBC.
